

## FILE BROWSER MODE SETUP



**WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU CREATE A DATABASE WITH THE DATABASE MANAGER TO GET THE BEST RESULT FROM ALL CORTEX PRODUCTS.**

**These are some tips on getting peak performance from the FILE BROWSER MODE.**

- The way your hard drive is set-up will go a long way in determining your Cortex's performance in FILE BROWSER MODE.

- We recommend that you keep a **MAXIMUM** of 1000 songs or 10GB worth of songs in each separate folder. Anything above this limit will increase the units processing time when accessing a specific folder. By increasing the processing time you will be waiting longer for your files to appear.

- Please avoid putting folders inside of existing folders. Please put each folder directly on to your external USB device.

- When using a larger hard drive the unit will need a longer period of time to access the FILE BROWSER MODE. If you are using a drive that is 80GB or larger, we highly recommend avoiding the FILE BROWSER MODE.

- If you plan on using FILE BROWSER MODE throughout your gig, please access it first when powering on the unit. If you are trying to access a larger folder on one side while a song is playing on the other, you may cause a slight skip on the existing file.

- Keep in mind that creating playlists is also an extremely fast and simple way to locate your music.

- Again, please remember that the recommended way to search for music is through setting up a database. You can either do this on your unit or with the newest version of our DB Manager for your PC or Mac. We decided to include FILE BROWSER MODE into our Cortex products to give our users every possible resource available to make their performance as smooth and user friendly imaginable. By not following the guidelines above, the FILE BROWSER MODE will not perform at the high level it is capable of.
